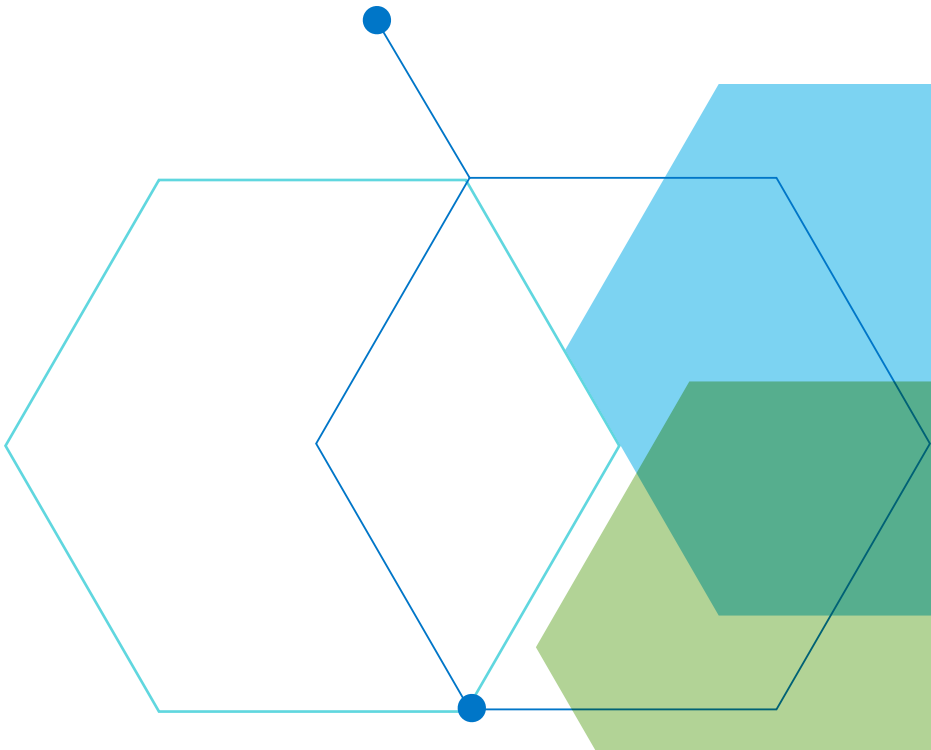

The American College of Surgeons (ACoS) Commission on Cancer (CoC) is a consortium of professional organizations dedicated to improving survival and quality of life for cancer patients through standard-setting, prevention, research, education, and monitoring of comprehensive quality care.

In compliance with the CoC standard 1.12, Evangelical Community Hospital (ECH) presents the follow program outcomes report.

The purpose and objectives of this report are to disseminate the outcomes of the 2013 oncology programs administered by the Cancer Committee.



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# Cancer Program Practice Profile Reports (CP3R)

The National Quality Forum (NQF) brought public and private payers together with consumers, researchers, and clinicians to broaden consensus of performance measures for breast and colorectal cancer. The Commission on Cancer is actively engaged in this process.

Four of the measures in the CP3R are endorsed by the NQF as accountability measures and are standards of care based on clinical trial evidence.



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# CP3R standards for Breast Cancer

Radiation therapy is administered within 1 year of diagnosis for women under the age of 70 receiving conserving surgery for breast cancer.

- **ECH program calculated performance rate: 96.4%**
- **One patient refused treatment.**

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Combination chemotherapy is considered or administered within 4 months of diagnosis for women under the age of 70 with AJCC T1cN0M0 or Stage II or III hormone receptor negative breast cancer

- **ECH program calculated performance rate: 100%**

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Tamoxifen or third generation aromatase inhibitor is considered or administered within 1 year of diagnosis for women with AJCC T1cN0M0 or Stage II or III breast cancer hormone receptor positive breast cancer.

- **ECH program calculated performance rate: 100%**
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# CP3R standards for Colon Cancer

Adjuvant chemotherapy is considered or administered within 4 months of diagnosis for patients under the age of 80 with AJCC Stage III colon cancer (lymph node positive).

- **ECH program calculated performance rate: 100%**

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At least 12 regional lymph nodes are removed and pathologically examined for resected colon cancer.

- **ECH program calculated performance rate: 73.3%**
- **The Cancer Program leadership at ECH continues to work with the surgeons and pathologists to improve compliance with this standard.**
